## Travel Log

Home Ministries has taken us from Arizona to New York - Minnesota to Florida. Some 30,000 miles have been logged on our odometer. We've enjoyed worshipping and sharing in country churches and city churches; bigger churches and smaller churches. We've always received a wonderful welcome and have enjoyed renewing friendships and partnerships in service.

So far, we have reached 92% of our needed support. Our start-up fund for housing & first-time investments in Panama is around 40%, and Perry's JIBACAM ministry account is 20%

We still have a full schedule ahead of us visiting churches and district conferences. We are hoping to go to Puerto Rico in June for a missions seminar and Perry will be going to Panama the first of August to teach a course for the pastors.
